INTERNATIONAL SUMMER SCHOOL THE ARCHITECTURE OF PALLADIO

The intensive program is dedicated to the architectural genius of Andrea Palladio, taught by leading academics and practitioners. Practical modules offer participants both taught and hands-on experiences. Combining individual assignments, group work, and one-to-one support from tutors provides a unique learning experience for students and practitioners in art, design, and architecture of all levels of ability and knowledge. The course offers an exceptional opportunity to learn from Andrea Palladio's masterpieces in Vicenza, including the Basilica and the Teatro Olimpico, as well as the palaces of Barbaran da Porto, Chiericati, Thiene, and Valmarana, and his most influential villa, La Rotonda. Additionally, in Venice, the churches of San Giorgio Maggiore and Redentore. It is a training workshop designed to learn his secrets and gain practical advice on classical architecture and orders, offering an opportunity to develop and improve skills in observational and measured drawing, as well as traditional architecture.

Participants will enjoy the historic centre of Vicenza and stay at Palazzo Valmarana Braga, designed by Andrea Palladio and featured in his "The Four Books of Architecture."

LIVE AND DRAW TRADITIONAL AND CLASSICAL ARCHITECTURE IN VICENZA

Palladian architecture, characterized by harmony, classical proportions, and innovation, has profoundly influenced Western urban planning and art, giving rise to the style of "Palladianism" that has spread throughout the world.

The course is dedicated to architectural design, beginning with the legacy of Andrea Palladio, and includes didactic modules that offer participants both theoretical lessons and practical experiences. These modules provide opportunities to practice drawing

from life and learn traditional drawing techniques, as well as classical architectural composition.

Participants,

- will live in the heart of Vicenza and travel to Possagno, and Venice;
- will be able to perform architectural design according to Palladio's lessons
- will practice the technical representation of classical architecture;
- will receive tuition in hands-on skills, measured and freehand drawing, drawing skills, traditional techniques, and documentation projects;
- will be taught classical architecture principles, Renaissance orders, and their design features;
- will practice graphical assignments inspired by Andrea Palladio projects.

SCHOOL VENUE

Vicenza, located in the heart of the Veneto region, which includes Verona, Venice, and Padua. It is a city that perfectly embodies the meeting of history, art, and architecture. Recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1994, Vicenza is universally known as the "city of Andrea Palladio", in honor of the famous Renaissance architect who left some of his most iconic works here.

Vicenza, therefore, offers architecture students a real open-air laboratory. Studying in Vicenza means immersing yourself in the living history of architecture, among unique monuments and an urban fabric rich in suggestions.

Vicenza can be reached via the airports of Venice, Treviso, Verona, Bergamo, and Bologna, as well as with high-speed train connections from Milan, Bergamo, Florence, Bologna, and Rome.

ENROLMENT

The admission fee, including accommodation, is **1500 euros** per person. The cost includes: educational activities in English, a welcome kit with a tour book, private tours, transfers to Venice and Possagno, museum tickets (Palladio Museum, Villa La Rotonda, Teatro Olimpico, Palazzo Chiericati, Antonio Canova Museum), welcome and farewell dinner, and **the extraordinary chance to be accommodated (in a shared apartment) at Palazzo Valmarana Braga in Vicenza, designed by Andrea Palladio.** (www.palazzoalmaranabraga.it)

The fee does not include any airport shuttle costs, travel tickets, or health insurance.

The cancellation fee is the entire admission fee, for latecomers' applications, after April 5th, 1.600 euros
